## Mare Breeding Veterinary Contract River Hills Stud 2009 Season

Reproductive work will be performed by equine Veterinarian and practice principal Ben Poole.

The contract fee for the 2009 season is **\$600.00 inc. GST. This fee must be paid before mare reproductive work is undertaken.**

### The fee is inclusive of :-

- Routine vaginal, uterine and ovarian examinations and pregnancy testing including all rectal manual palpations and ultrasound scans
- Routine pre- and post-breeding treatments, including infused uterine antibiotics
- The use of standard reproductive drugs including ovulation induction drugs, oxytocin, prostaglandin.
- Reduction of twin pregnancies
- Certificate of Pregnancy after 45 day scan
- Travel to and from the stud for routine visits

### The fee excludes the following : -

- Caslicks and related procedures if required.
- Progesterone for treatment of transitional oestrus or maintenance of pregnancy
- Clitoral and/or uterine swabs if required.
- Veterinary attendance, diagnosis and treatment of other conditions of the mare other than routine reproductive work, e.g. foaling, retained foetal membranes, illness.

The contract will end when your mare receives a 45 day positive pregnancy test (and certificate) or, if she fails to conceive, by 24<sup>th</sup> December 2009. Extraneous fees will be charged to your account and invoiced monthly. Payment is expected at 30 days.

It is important to note that vaginal, uterine and ovarian palpation and ultrasound of mares involves a per-rectal examination. These procedures are important in the reproductive management of mares but they carry a small risk of inadvertent, serious injury to the mare.

Some thoroughbred mares conceive a multiple pregnancy. These are routinely managed by early identification and reduction to a single pregnancy. This procedure is usually successful, but occasionally can result in the loss of both embryos.
